Project Name: Wildflower Station Townhomes 2 Multifamily Residential (TM-02, AR-23-05)

Location: Northeast corner of Hillcrest Avenue and Wildflower Drive
(APN: 052-140-013, 014, 015, and 016)

Description: The applicant, Kathryn Watt on behalf of DeNova Homes, Inc., is seeking approval of a Vesting Tentative Subdivision Map and Design Review for the creation of 19 residential lots and 17 common area parcels for 159 multifamily townhome units in 19 buildings on a +/- 7.93-acre site. The project includes an internal road network, open space, landscaping, stormwater facilities, and utilities to serve the project site.

CEQA: The project is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to Community Plan Exemption section 15183 of the CEQA Guidelines because the project is consistent with the development density established by the existing zoning and general plan policies.
