

BIDDER'S CERTIFICATION

I acknowledge receipt of this Addendum No. 1 and accept all conditions contained herein.

- 1) Pre-Bid Inquiry No. 1: Is there a mandatory DBE-MBE-WBE goal for this project?

Answer: There is no mandatory DBE-MBE-WBE goal for this project, but the City is encouraging and tracking their participation by contractors and subs.

- 2) Pre-Bid Inquiry No. 2: The form asks that the bidders when possible advertise 15 days prior to bid. Is this a mandatory requirement?

Answer: This is not a mandatory requirement.

- 3) Pre-Bid Inquiry No. 3: If we are a WBE but not certified by the State will this count?

Answer: Yes, if the contractor can provide something to show that they are a WBE, that will count for our purposes.

- 4) Pre-Bid Inquiry No. 4: Will the LBE count as Section 3 requirement?

Answer: No, to qualify the contractor must hire lower income residents of Antioch. If laborers come from the union and are residents of Antioch, the City has a form to give them to sign to determine if they are lower income. We encourage contractors to try and incorporate Section 3 requirements to the best of your ability if hiring workers.

- 5) Pre-Bid Inquiry No. 5: A portion of B Street between West 7th and West 8th Streets is presently all concrete without any existing asphalt overlay. Can we expect to only place the 1" leveling and 2" overlay w/fabric in this area?

Answer: Yes, the schedule of bid prices has been adjusted accordingly.

- 6) Section B-4, "SCOPE OF WORK", subsection 4-1.06, "GUARANTY OF WORK", of the Project Special Provisions is amended to state the following:

"GUARANTY OF WORK. Contractor warrants to the City that all materials and equipment furnished under the Contract will be new unless otherwise specified, and that all work (without limitation, including all materials, equipment and workmanship) will be of the specified quality, free from faults and defects and in full and complete conformance with the Contract Documents. All work not conforming to these requirements, including substitutions not properly authorized by the Engineer, will be considered defective by the City.

Contractor hereby agrees to correct, repair and/or replace all defective work if the deficiencies are discovered by the City during a period of one (1) year from the date of City's acceptance of the Project or for such longer periods of time as set forth with respect to specific warranties elsewhere in these Contract Documents. In addition to making such corrections, repairs and/or replacements, Contractor shall correct, repair and/or replace any other components of the Project that are damaged as a result of such defective materials, equipment and/or workmanship.

Should Contractor fail to act promptly or in accordance with this requirement, or should the exigencies of the case require repairs or replacements to be made before Contractor can be notified, City may, as its option, make the necessary repairs or replacements or perform the necessary work and Contractor shall pay to City the actual cost of such repairs plus twenty-five percent (25%).

Nothing in this Section or in the Contract Documents shall be construed to limit the rights and remedies available to City at law or in equity, including, but not limited to, Code of Civil Procedure section 337.15."

- 7) Section B-9, "MEASUREMENT AND PAYMENT", subsection I, "REPAIR OR RECONSTRUCTION OF DEFECTIVE WORK", of the Project Special Provisions is deleted
- 8) The attached "Revised Schedule of Bid Prices" shall be submitted in lieu of the "Schedule of Bid Prices".
