

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Planning Commission of the City of Antioch will hold a public hearing at the Antioch Community Center, Community Hall A, 4703 Lone Tree Way, at 6:30 p.m. on September 4, 2019, on the following matter:

Residential Growth Management Ordinance Amendment – City staff is recommending that the Title 9, Chapter 5, Article 40 “Residential Growth Management” be amended to replace the annual maximum allocation limit with a rolling 5-year average and replace the one-year maximum development standard with a two-year maximum development standard. This project has been found to be Categorically Exempt from the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act.

If any person challenges the City’s decision on this matter in court, he or she may be limited to raising only those issues that were raised at the public hearing described in this notice or in written correspondence delivered to the City at or prior to the public hearing.
