


NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Planning Commission of the City of Antioch will hold a public hearing at 6:30 p.m. on April 7, 2021 on the following matter:

UP-20-03, AR-20-05 – Mt. Diablo Maintenance Facility – Mt. Diablo Resource and Recovery requests approval of an Initial Study / Mitigated Negative Declaration and Mitigation Monitoring and Report Program, a Use Permit and Design Review for a truck maintenance facility at 2600 Wilbur Avenue (APN: 051-051-021). The proposed project would be developed in three phases on a 10.28-acre site that is currently developed with a 9,730 square foot metal warehouse building and approximately 10,000 square feet of paved surface parking.
