
## NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Planning Commission of the City of Antioch will hold a public hearing at 6:30 p.m. on January 20, 2021, on the following matter:

GP-19-06, PD-19-02 - Creekside Vineyards at Sand Creek - The applicant, GBN Partners, LLC, is requesting approval of the proposed single-family development of 220 single-family residential units and associated improvements on approximately 58.9 acres of the 158.2-acre project site, as well as 1.8 acres of off-site improvements. The proposed residential units would consist of either non-age restricted units, senior/active adult units, or a combination of both. The project improvements would include, but would not be limited to, parks, trails, landscaping, circulation improvements, and utility installation. The remainder of the site, including Sand Creek and the associated buffer area, would be retained as open space. Necessary entitlements from the City include certification of an Environmental Impact Report, General Plan Amendment, Rezone to Planned Development District (PD), Vesting Tentative Subdivision Map, Resource Management Plan, and Design Review. The project site is bordered by the Contra Costa County line to the south and the City of Brentwood city limit to the east. Sand Creek is located to the north of the site, and State Route (SR) 4 is located approximately 0.38-mile east of the site. The project site is situated within the Sand Creek Focus Area of the General Plan, which contains lands designated by the City of Antioch General Plan for open space, residential, commercial, and mixed-use development (APN: 057-050-024).
