Project Name: Chevron Hydrogen Fuel Dispensing Facility (DR2023-0006, UP-2023-0003, VAR2023-0008)

- Location: 2413 A Street / APNs 068-132-038, 046, 052, and 053
- **Description:** The applicant requests a Use Permit, Variance and Design Review approval for a hydrogen fuel dispensing facility at an existing gas station. The project consists of hydrogen storage, associated equipment, two hydrogen dispensers located under a canopy, new landscaping, and stormwater control facilities. A variance is requested to reduce the minimum setback requirements of the canopy from 20 feet to 10 feet.
- **CEQA:** The project is Categorically Exempt under California Environmental Quality Act Guidelines Sectio 15303, New Construction of Small Structures. Class 3 consists of construction and location of limited numbers of new, small facilities or structures.
