**Project Name:** The Ranch Project – Phase II / PD2023-0003

Location: West of Deer Valley Road, South of Mammoth Way/ APNs: 057-010-002, 057-010-003, and 057-

021-003

**Description:** The applicant, Richland Planned Communities, Inc. is requesting the following entitlements for

Phase II of The Ranch Project:

1. Vesting Tentative Subdivision Map. The proposed project requires approval of a Vesting Tentative Subdivision Map to divide the Phase II area into 213 Low-Density-Conventional (LD-3) residential lots, 13.0 acres of parkland, 11.5 acres of open space, 2.3 acres of landscaping, and 12.4 acres of internal roadway network.

2. *Use Permit*. The project requires the approval of a Use Permit to allow for the development of the proposed uses within the Phase II area of The Ranch Project site.

CEQA:

An EIR was prepared for The Ranch Project in accordance with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) and was certified by the City Council on July 28, 2020 (SCH No. 2019060012). The 2020 EIR analyzed development of Phase I, Phase II, and Phase III of The Ranch Project, which would consist of 1,177 residential units over 253.5 acres on a 551.5 acre site, including LD residential units, Medium Density (MD) residential units, and Age Restricted (AR) residential units; a 5.0-acre Village Center consisting of commercial, office, and retail space; 3.0 acres of public services facilities, including a new fire station site and a trail staging area; approximately 22.5 acres of public parks and landscaped areas; 229.5 acres of open space including trails; and 38.0 acres of roadway improvements, and recommends mitigation measures to reduce impacts to the maximum extent feasible.
