Storm and Rain Season is upon us!

To report street flooding, fallen trees or limbs, plugged storm drains or culverts, traffic signals or streetlights out or street signs down please call (925) 779-6950, Monday through Friday from 7:00 am to 4:00 pm. or email us at publicworks@antiochca.gov. The Public Works office is located at 1201 West 4th Street.

For after-hours our emergency standby crew is on call seven days a week, 24 hours a day, call (925) 778-2441.

During storms, we will clear downed trees and limbs from the roadway, and clean-up crews will return to pick up debris after the storm. Our phones can become very busy during major storms, so we ask for your patience. Please use email to support our efforts to serve our customers as quickly and efficiently as possible.

The **City's sandbag station** is self-serve and open 24 hours a day for the storm's duration. The sandbag distribution site is located at the City's corporation yard at **1201 W 4th Street (enter at N Street)**.
