



# How To Recycle Used Motor Oil & Oil Filters



## ***Antioch Residents have many convenient choices:***

- 1) **Curbside Collection**- Pleasant Hill Bayshore Disposal will collect motor oil and filters as part of your regular recycling service. Here's how:

Motor oil-

- Pour motor oil into clear plastic containers with secure lids.
- Seal and place beside your recycling bin.
- Maximum of 3 gallons of oil per pickup.

Oil Filters-

- Remove your oil filters from your car and drain excess oil.
- Place used oil filter in a CLEAR plastic zip-lock bag and place it next to your recycling bin on your next service day.

- 2) **Drop off** - The following locations accept motor oil and you can get 4¢ per quart back! Call center for hours of operation and quantities accepted.
