On motion by Board Member Schneider, seconded by Board Member Adeyemi, the Board of Administrative Appeals unanimously approved the minutes of December 4, 2014.

2. APPEALS

A. CITATION NO. 23822 - APPEAL OF ADMINISTRATIVE CITATION ISSUED REGARDING SPECIFIC NUISANCES PROHIBITED: PARKING AND STORAGE OF VEHICLES AND EQUIPMENT - UNIMPROVED SURFACE [§5-1.202(D)(2)] FOR KENNY DE RESPINI, 403 W. 19TH STREET, ANTIOCH, CA

City Attorney Nerland announced the appellant was not present and recommended the Appeal be heard by the Board of Administrative Appeals. She noted if the appellant arrived he would be allowed the opportunity to speak on this item.

Code Enforcement Officer Shuck presented the staff report dated December 17, 2014 recommending the Board of Administrative Appeals uphold the Administrative Citation issued to Kenny DeRespini for violation of the Antioch Municipal Code § 5-1.202 (D) (2).

In response to Board Member Adeyemi, Deputy Director of Community Development Graham explained the citation fee was a tool for compliance and the inspection fee was for the City to recoup the cost of the inspections. He added that if the violation is cleared after the notice of violation and prior to the follow-up inspection, the appellant would not have incurred any fees.

On motion by Board Member Rouse, seconded by Board Member Adeyemi, the Board of Administrative Appeals unanimously upheld the Administrative Citation issued to Kenny DeRespini for violation of the Antioch Municipal Code § 5-1.202 (D) (2).

FISCAL IMPACT

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Pursuant to Antioch Municipal Code §1-5.09 the City may collect any past due Administrative Citation fines, Abatements or late payment charges by use of special assessment liens and all action for recovery of money.

A Notice of Intent to Record Lien was sent to each property owner who is entitled to notice reflecting the property address directly connected to conditions or activities on the subject real property, assessors parcel number, the municipal code violation, administrative citation fine and copy of the administrative citations.

Violation of Antioch Municipal Codes §7-2-623

REQUEST:

Mr. Allen & Anastasia Broussard request a hearing to appeal Administrative Citation # 23881 issued on January 6, 2015, citing violation of the Antioch Municipal Code Sections:

§7-2.623 No encroachment of any nature shall be permitted or maintained which impedes, obstructs, or denies such pedestrian or other lawful travel within the limits of the right-of-way of a public street or which impairs adequate sight distance for safe pedestrian or vehicular traffic.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

On 12-3-14, Code Enforcement administrative staff received a complaint of a motor home blocking the sidewalk and into the street at Neah Court Antioch, Ca. The reporting party also reported that it is blocking the view around the corner causing unsafe driving conditions.

On 12-9-14, I conducted a site inspection at large motor home encroaching on the public right away and into the street causing a site obstruction to the neighboring property. I prepared a Notice of Violation letter for Antioch Municipal Code violation

§7-2.623 Encroachment on the public right of way. I mailed the Notice of Violation letter by first class mail to the listed property owner on file by the County Assessor's office to Allen & Anastasia Broussard at Neah Court Antioch, CA 94509. A photo and a copy of the Notice of Violation letter are hereto attached as Exhibit "A".



On <u>1-6-15</u>, I conducted a follow up inspection and observed the same motor home encroaching on the public right of way and a causing a visual sight obstruction. I issued an Administrative citation in the amount of \$100.00 and a \$125.00 re-inspection fee. The citation was mailed to the property owner first class mail to the same address as the Notice of Violation letter Neah Court Antioch, CA 94509. Photos, citation and re-inspection fee sheet attached hereto as Exhibit "B".

On 1-12-15, Mrs. Broussard filed an appeal and is attached hereto as Exhibit "C".

RECOMMENDATION:

Recommendation to uphold the Administrative Citation issued to Allen & Anastasia Broussard for violation of the Antioch Municipal Codes §7-2.623.





- On January 6, 2015, CEO Souza conducted a follow up inspection and observed the motor home still encroaching on the public right-of-way and causing a site obstruction. A \$200.00 Administrative citation was issued to Allen & Anastasia Broussard and mailed to

Mr. Alberto Vitug requests a hearing to appeal Administrative Citation # 23883 issued on January 7, 2015, citing violation of the Antioch Municipal Code Sections:

§5-1.202(A2) Premises on which overgrown, dead or decayed trees, weeds or other vegetation pose a risk of harm to the public, or constitute visual blight or reduce the aesthetic appearance of the neighborhood, or are offensive to the senses, or are detrimental to the use and enjoyment of nearby properties, or reduce nearby property values due to its visibility from the public right-of-way.

§5-1.202(B) Any building or other structure, including, but not limited to, walls, fences, signs or retaining walls, which are broken, deteriorated, or substantially defaced (including defacement by markings commonly referred to as "graffiti") so that the disrepair poses a risk of harm to the public, or constitutes visual blight or reduces the aesthetic appearance of the neighborhood, or is offensive to the senses, or is detrimental to the use and enjoyment of nearby properties, or reduces nearby property values due to its visibility from the public right-of-way.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

On <u>11-17-2014</u>, I was conducting an inspection of a nearby property when I observed Antioch Municipal Code violations in public view on the property of Mokelumne Drive Antioch, Ca.

On 11-17-2014, I prepared a Notice of Violation letter for Antioch Municipal Code violations §5-1.202(A2) Overgrown vegetation and §5-1.202(B) Fence in disrepair. I posted a copy of the Notice of Violation on the front door and mailed a copy of the Notice of Violation letter by first class mail to the listed property owner on file by the County Assessor's office to Alberto & Henrietta Vitug at Mokelumne Drive Antioch, CA 94531. Photos and a copy of the Notice of Violation letter are hereto attached as Exhibit "A".

On <u>12-4-14</u>, I received a phone message from Mr. Vitug asking for a return phone call. I called Mr. Vitug and he said that he had hired a landscaper to take care of the overgrowth and the fence but he needed more time because of the rain. I asked Mr. Vitug if the house was vacant and he replied that he lived there. I gave Mr. Vitug an extension until the 17th of December.

On 12-17-14, I received another phone call from Mr. Vitug asking for another extension because he is trying to refinance his house and because of the rain. I gave him another extension until the 31st of December.

On 1-7-15, I conducted a follow up inspection and observed the overgrowth and fence in disrepair remain the same and in public view. I issued an Administrative Citation in the amount of \$200.00 (\$100.00 for each violation) and a \$125.00 re-inspection fee. Photos were taken. The photos, citation and re-inspection fee sheet are attached hereto as Exhibit "B".

On 1-9-15, Mr. Vitug filed an appeal and is attached hereto as Exhibit "C".

On <u>1-20-15</u>, I conducted another follow up inspection and the violations remain the same on the property. Photos attached hereto as Exhibit "D".



- 3. The Citation concerns Municipal Code violations at Mokelumne Drive, Antioch, California. At all relevant times Appellant was the owner of the property and/or the responsible party.
- 4. Appellant appealed Citation No. 23883 on January 13, 2015.
- 5. An Administrative Appeals Board Hearing regarding the appeal was set for February 5, 2015 at 3:00 p.m. at the Antioch City Council Chambers, and the Appellant was duly notified by the City Clerk.

Chapter 5 of Title 1 of the Antioch Municipal Code allows police officers, as well as other City
officials enumerated in the Municipal Code to issue administrative citations to persons
responsible for a violation of the Antioch Municipal Code.

II. SPECIFIC FINDINGS:

An Administrative Appeals Board Hearing regarding Appellant's appeal of the Citation was duly held on February 5, 2015, at 3:00 p.m. Evidence, both oral and documentary, was taken and based on the preponderance of said evidence, the following specific findings are made:

- On November 17, 2014, CEO Souza conducted an inspection and a Notice of Violation letter
 was sent to Alberto & Henrietta Vitug (property owner) of Mokelumne Drive, Antioch,
 CA for violations of the Antioch Municipal Codes.
- 2. On December 4, 2014, CEO Souza received a phone call from Mr. Vitug requesting an extension to bring the property into compliance. An extension was granted until the 17th of December.
- On December 17, 2014, CEO Souza received a phone call from Mr. Vitug requesting another extension to bring the property into compliance. An extension was granted until the 31st of December.
- 4. On January 7, 2015, CEO Souza conducted a follow up inspection and the violations had not been corrected. An Administrative citation was issued to Alberto & Henrietta Vitug in the amount of \$200.00 (\$100.00 for overgrown vegetation and \$100.00 for fence in disrepair.) A \$125.00 re-inspection fee was also issued to Alberto & Henrietta Vitug.
- 5. On January 9, 2015, Mr. Vitug filed an appeal for an Administrative hearing.
- On January 20, 2015, CEO Souza conducted another inspection and the violations remain on the property and in public view.
- 7. Appellant has continued conduct in violation of Antioch Municipal Code section §5-1.202(A2) and §5-1.202(B) despite the warnings.
- 8. The Board finds that the reasons given by Appellant for these ongoing violations are not credible and are not mitigations for her unlawful conduct.

Based on a preponderance of evidence, the Board finds that there was probable cause to issue the citation and the appeal is denied. The citation deposit amount will not be refunded.

Notice of this decision shall be given to the Appellant, by hand delivering a copy of these Findings and Decision to Appellant or by mailing a copy by first class U.S. Mail, addressed to Alberto & Henrietta Vitug, Mokelumne Drive, Antioch, CA, 94509.
