Chairperson Rouse called the meeting to order at 3:17 p.m. on Thursday, April 15, 2010, in the City Council Chambers.

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

1. APPEALS

A. Appeal to reverse potentially Dangerous Animals decision for dogs Maxi (A093904), Jordan (A085103), Bobby (A077041) for Patricia Oliva, 1504 Hill Drive, Antioch [§6-1.22 (A)(b)].

City Attorney Nerland explained the manner in which the proceedings would be conducted.

Board Member Simpson arrived at 3:22 PM

Supervisor of Animal Services Helgemo presented the staff report dated April 7, 2010, recommending the Board of Administrative Appeals uphold the decision of the February 2, 2010, Dangerous Animal Hearing declaring all three dogs as "Vicious Animals" based on Antioch Municipal Code Section 6-1-22 and that the dog owners abide by the stipulations being imposed for them to regain custody of their animals.

City Attorney Nerland reviewed the options available for the Appeals Board.

APPELLANT

Mr. Reynoso elected to have assistance from City approved interpreter Christina Garcia.

Felipe Reynoso speaking on behalf of Patricia Oliva stated he was agreeable to pay the money owed and to spay/neuter his pets. He noted he was aware of why his dogs were impounded. He reported his neighbors did not agree with the decision to declare his animals "Vicious". He submitted several questionnaires responded to from neighbors indicating they had not witnessed the dogs running loose, exhibiting aggressive behavior or barking excessively.

In response to Board Member Schnieder, Mr. Reynoso clarified he was appealing the decision deeming the animals "Vicious".

In response to Board Member Schleder, Mr. Reynoso stated he did not witness the incident and there was no sign of blood on his animals. He noted Mr. Sisney had told neighbors prior to this incidence that he wanted the dogs removed due to excessive barking. He further noted his dogs were not aggressive.

OPPONENTS

Per the request by Nancy Strickland, Chairperson Rouse read the letter submitted from Sandra Baltzell in support of Ms. Oliva regarding the unwarranted seizure of her pets. Additionally, the questionnaire previously submitted by Mr. Reynoso was described and provided for the public to review.

Nancy Strickland spoke in support of Mr. and Mrs. Sisney and noted she believed the dogs were vicious. She reported the appellant's dogs had an extensive history of running loose and she felt they were neglected.

Richard Sisney, cat owner, reported the appellant had 18 previous complaints and they had yet to comply with the City. He expressed concern they also exceeded the City's maximum for dog ownership. He noted the appellant admitted at the previous hearing that her dogs killed his cats. He urged the City to not return the dogs to the owners as he felt they were not responsible pet owners. He reported he witnessed the dogs killing one cat and they turned on him when he attempted to intervene. He stated he had repaired the fence from the dogs previously breaking out boards, however; the dogs broke out adjacent boards to gain access the day of the incident.

Clara Sisney, cat owner, stated she witnessed the Husky mauling one of her cats and she called Ms. Oliva who came over and retrieved her dogs. She stated her granddaughter, who was at the scene during the incident, is still afraid and felt the dogs should not be returned to the owner.

PROPONENT

Alejandro Alvarez, neighbor speaking on behalf of the dog owner and the neighbors who submitted questionnaires, stated the fences are old and that was how the dogs obtained access. He noted Ms. Oliva's dogs had gotten into his yard and they had not been aggressive

with his dog or children. He stated the dogs involved in this incidence do not run loose in the neighborhood.

REBUTTAL

Supervisor of Animal Services Helgemo clarified the incident being discussed that evening were the dogs being loose and killing domestic animals. She noted they gave Ms. Oliva the opportunity to have her dogs back with stipulations to prevent the dogs from attacking and killing other animals. She reported they had a call for service from Ms. Baltzell regarding one of Ms. Oliva's dogs being loose and there was a history of five other neighbors reporting the Oliva's dog, "Lucky" being loose. She stated there was no dispute that the dogs killed the cats and City Code stated, "If dogs kill another animal off their property, they can be redeemed and declared Vicious Animals with stipulations".

REBUTTAL

Ms. Oliva elected to have assistance from City approved interpreter Christina Garcia.

Patricia Oliva stated her dogs had never hurt her cat and they bark when they are in the backyard. She stated at the previous hearing there was a break, staff continued to talk and she did not feel the decision was equal. She noted her 13-year old dog "Lucky" does run into the street, however, he comes back when called. She clarified she had never had more than four dogs and expressed concern she had been denied visits with her dogs at the shelter.

In response to Board Member Simpson, Ms. Oliva stated when she retrieved her dogs from the Sisney's backyard, they were playing and she saw the dead cats, however; there was no physical evidence of harm.

In response to Board Member Schneider, Ms. Oliva stated the fence that was loose was on the Sisney's side. She stated on the day prior to the incident, she was told the fence was loose and she was going to repair it, however, prior to the repairs the incident occurred. She reported she had used a bark collar, which did not work. She further noted the cats had been in her yard prior to this incident occurring.

In response to Board Member Simpson, Supervisor of Animal Services Helgemo explained that except for the officer called to the scene immediately following the incident, the cats were not examined by the City.

Chairperson Rouse closed the public hearing.

Board Member Schneider, addressing the questionnaire/petitions submitted, stated that given the fact they were not notarized and the individuals were not available to answer questions from the Appeals Board, the validity and authenticity was in question. He noted he would base his decision on the testimony and the validated report.

Board Member Schleder expressed concern that the questionnaires/petitions did not include signatures.

Board Member Simpson added none of the individuals who filled out the questionnaires/petitions were present when the incident occurred.

Board Member Schneider stated the dog owner admitted responsibility for the dog and knowingly allowed her dogs to be a nuisance to the neighborhood. Additionally, she exceeded the City's Policy for the amount of dogs allowed and did not secure her fence to eliminate access. He stated that even though the report did not indicate the dogs attacked the cats when unprovoked, Mr. Sisney was approached in an aggressive manner by the dogs when he attempted to intervene. He noted given the lack of responsibility by the owners of the dogs, he would recommend sustaining the City's recommendation finding the dogs "Vicious".

Chairperson Rouse expressed concern the dogs displayed aggressive behavior toward the cat owner upon trying to retrieve or protect the cat. Additionally, he noted compliance with the conditions stipulated in the report was not unreasonable. He added the petition/questionnaires did not have affidavit weight associated; therefore he would not take them under consideration.

On motion by Board Member Schneider, seconded by Board Member Simpson, the Administrative Board of Appeals members present upheld the decision of the February 2, 2010, Dangerous Animal Hearing declaring all three dogs as "Vicious Animals" based on Antioch Municipal Code Section 6-1-22, not to be euthanized, subject to the terms and conditions of the Dangerous Animal Declaration.

ADMINISTRATIVE APPEALS

14 I. GENERAL FINDINGS:

- 15 1. City of Antioch Citation No. 0651 was voided.
- 16 2. City of Antioch Citation No. 0652 (1604 S. Francisco Ct., Antioch, CA) was duly issued on
17 March 20, 2012 citing two violations of the Antioch Municipal Code section 5-17.03, which
18 states the following: "No person shall operate any loudspeaker or sound amplifier or device in
19 such a manner as to cause any sound to be projected outside of any building or vehicle in any
20 part of the city, except during public events or in the dissemination of matters of interest to the
21 general public, and then only upon a permit from the Chief of Police."
- 22 3. The Citation concerns Municipal Code violations at 1604 S. Francisco Ct., Antioch, California.
At all relevant times Appellant was the owner of the property and/or the responsible party.
- 23 4. Appellant appealed Citation No. 0652 on April 5, 2012.
- 24 5. An Administrative Appeals Board Hearing regarding the appeal was set for April 26, 2012 at 3:00
25 p.m. at the Antioch City Council Chambers, and the Appellant was duly notified by the City
Clerk.
- 26 6. Chapter 5 of Title 1 of the Antioch Municipal Code allows police officers, as well as other City
27 officials enumerated in the Municipal Code to issue administrative citations to persons
28 responsible for a violation of the Antioch Municipal Code.

2 II. SPECIFIC FINDINGS:

3 An Administrative Appeals Board Hearing regarding Appellant's appeal of the Citation was duly held
4 on April 26, 2012, at 3:00 p.m. A certified American Sign Language Interpreter was provided by the
5 City for Appellant. Evidence, both oral and documentary, was taken and based on the preponderance
6 of said evidence, the following specific findings are made:

- 7 1. On March 20, 2012, Antioch Police Dispatch was called regarding loud noise complaints from
8 1604 S. Francisco Court, Antioch, California. There is evidence of long-standing complaints
9 from neighbors regarding loud noise from 1604 S. Francisco Court, Antioch, CA including
10 beeper and drum noise at late hours, as evidenced by recent Antioch Police Department Event
11 Reports 12-025094, 12-02499, 11-107667 and 11-102094.
12 2. It has been conveyed to Appellant numerous times in a manner that he can understand, such as
13 phone relay translation or writing, that Appellant must stop making loud noises and playing
14 loud music that can be heard by neighbors, particularly during nighttime hours.
15 3. Appellant has continued conduct in violation of Antioch Municipal Code section 5-17.03
16 despite the warnings.
17 4. The Board finds that the reasons given by Appellant for these ongoing noise violations are not
18 credible and are not mitigations for his unlawful conduct.

19 Based on a preponderance of evidence, the Board finds that there was probable cause to issue the citation and the
20 appeal is denied. The citation deposit amount will not be refunded.

21 III. NOTICE:

22 Notice of this decision shall be given to the Appellant, by hand delivering a copy of these Findings
23 and Decision to Appellant or by mailing a copy by first class U.S. Mail, addressed to Brett Kuntze,
24 1604 S. Francisco Ct, Antioch, CA, 94509.
