**DANGEROUS DOGS AND ANIMALS (A)(b)**

**REQUEST:**

Appellate Jacqueline Wight requests a hearing to appeal the status of a Potentially Dangerous Animal declared on September 18, 2012 citing violation of the Antioch Municipal Code § 6-1.22 DANGEROUS DOGS AND ANIMALS (A)(b) which describes a Potentially Dangerous Dog as...(b) Any dog or animal which, when unprovoked, bites a person causing a less severe injury than as defined herein as a *SEVERE INJURY*.

**BACKGROUND INFORMATION:**

**Responsible Dog Owner:**

- Jacqueline Wight - Redwood Drive, Antioch, CA 94509

**Responsible Dogs:**

- "Bubba" #A507033 - Male, red/white, Pit Bull, expired license, no current rabies vaccination on record with the City of Antioch
- "Roxy" #A102104 - Female, red/white, Pit Bull, expired license, no current rabies vaccination on record with the City of Antioch
- "Chevelle" #A102105 - Female, red, Pit Bull, expired license, no current rabies vaccination on record with the City of Antioch

January 14, 2012 Bubba was involved in a dog on dog attack after the fence was broken between the two homes (See event 12-004322). The dog involved was taken to a veterinary

hospital for medical attention and Bubba along with two puppies at the time Chevelle and Roxy were taken due to the unsecure fence. Owner was contacted. All three dogs were redeemed later that day (see receipt R12-000144).

On June 20, 2012 Roxy was picked up for being out and getting hit by a car. Animal Control Officer Gomez was called out and took the dog to the emergency vet (See event 12-057303).

On June 23, 2012 Roxy was returned to owner after paying her emergency vet bill, and impound fees in full. Both Chevelle and Roxy were issued temporary licenses (see receipt R12-0001720).

**CURRENT INCIDENT:**

On August 24, 2012 Mr. Victor Silva reported that he was attacked by three of his neighbors' dogs (see event 12-079479). An APD Officer arrived and took the report (see case 12-008031). They photographed Mr. Silva's injuries and he was taken to the emergency room.

Per the report the three dogs lived at .. Redwood Drive. At the time, he attempted to make contact with the owner of the dogs, but no one appeared to be home.

On August 27, I was dispatched to .. Redwood Drive to impound the three (3) dogs that were involved in attacking the elderly neighbor (See event 12-080481). Prior to making contact I was advised that the three dogs belonged to Jacqueline Wight at that address. All three (3) dogs had history with our office. All the dogs had expired Antioch dog licenses and rabies vaccination. My first attempt to make contact with Mrs. Wight was unsuccessful. I left an administrative citation for no rabies x3, no licenses x3, animals at large x3, violating quarantined x3, and failing to report a dog bite x3. I made a note on the citation requesting she call our office. I also made a note the dogs needed to be impounded pending the investigation.

On September 5, 2012 I made a second attempt to make contact with Ms. Wight (See event 12-083516). At this visit I was able to determine that there were dogs in the backyard. I was knocking on the door for several minutes. Eventually a blonde, white female who identified herself to me as Tammy Deal answered the door. She stated she was a friend of Ms. Wight. When I asked her if Ms. Wight was home, she answered me with ..."the dogs didn't do anything, that man gets up on the fence and teases the dogs..." I asked her if she was there when the dogs attacked the neighbor she said no and then told me that Ms. Wight was at work. I asked her if she had Ms. Wight work or cell phone number so I could make contact with her regarding the dogs. Ms. Deal refused to help with either turning over the dogs or making

contact with Ms. Wight. I left a second administrative citation for the same violations as prior and asked Ms. Deals to give it to her when she came home.

On September 6, 2012 I made my third attempt to impound the dogs. Ms. Wight was home along with Jeremiah Hampton. Ms. Wight insisted on having the conversation through the front security screen door. I identified myself to her and informed her that APD and Animals services has been trying to get a hold of her regarding the allegations that her three (3) dogs attacked the elderly man next door. Ms. Wight said that her dogs didn't do anything. I asked her if she was with the dogs at the time of the alleged incident. She told me she was not, her friend, Jeremiah was with them then. Jeremiah then came out and told me he was there with the dogs that day. He said the dogs were off leash heading to his car. The dogs walked up to the next door neighbor and sniffed him. He called the dogs back to him and they got in the car and they left. The other people that were there started talking and saying things like it wasn't their dogs that attacked the man, possible it was his own dogs. The victim does not have any dogs. Then someone said that it was a man "of color" that is always peaking over the fence and throwing things at the dogs. I told them all to write up a statement if they wish to have their words submitted in my case. But as of that point I had an eye witness saying these dogs attacked him and a photograph of Jeremiah getting in a car with the dogs and leaving before the police arrived. The dogs needed to be quarantine and would be under investigation for the PDA title. Reluctantly Ms. Wight brought one of the females out. She was identified as "Roxy" red female Pit bull. Roxy had three (3) puppies with her. Ms. Deal said she had them three days prior. I asked with only three puppies in the litter what happened to the rest of them and she said they all died. I had to impound the puppies with the mom since they needed her for their survival. I then impounded "Chevelle" a female, red pit bull and "Bubba" a male, red/white pit bull.

On September 18, 2012 after supervisor Helgemo went over my findings she declared the three adult pit bulls Potentially Dangerous Animals under AMC 6-1.22 Potentially Dangerous animal (b) Any dog or animal which, when unprovoked, bites a person causing a less severe injury than as defined herein as a *SEVERE INJURY*.

**RECOMMENDATION:**

Due to the current violation of AMC 6-1.22 by the dogs and the injuries received by the victim, as well as the previous violations of the Antioch Municipal Code, it is staff recommendation to uphold the Potentially Dangerous Animal declaration for all three dogs.

## **§ 6-1.22 DANGEROUS DOGS AND ANIMALS.**

(A) **Definitions.** For the purpose of this section, the following definitions shall apply unless the context indicates or requires a different meaning.

**POTENTIALLY DANGEROUS DOG OR ANIMAL.** Any of the following:

- (a) Any dog or animal which, when unprovoked, on two separate occasions within the prior 36-month period, engages in any behavior that requires a defensive action by any person to prevent bodily injury to that person or another animal when the person and potentially dangerous dog or animal are off the property of the owner or keeper of the potentially dangerous dog or animal;
- (b) Any dog or animal which, when unprovoked, bites a person causing a less severe injury than as defined herein as a **SEVERE INJURY**; or
- (c) Any dog or animal which, when unprovoked, has killed, seriously bitten, inflicted injury, or otherwise caused injury attacking a domestic animal off the property of the owner or keeper of the potentially dangerous dog or animal.

**VICIOUS DOG OR ANIMAL.** Any of the following:

- (a) Any dog or animal seized under Cal. Penal Code § 599aa and upon the sustaining of a conviction of the owner or keeper under Cal. Penal Code § 597.5(a);
- (b) Any dog or animal which, when unprovoked, in an aggressive manner, inflicts severe injury on or kills a human being or domestic animal off the property of the owner or keeper of the potentially dangerous dog or animal; or
- (c) Any dog previously determined to be and currently listed as a potentially dangerous dog or animal, which after its owner or keeper has been notified of this determination, continues the behavior of a potentially dangerous dog or is not secured on its owner's property.

**SECURED.** Contained within a fence or structure suitable to prevent the entry of young children and which is suitable to confine a vicious dog or animal, designed to prevent the animal from escaping.

**SEVERE INJURY.** Any physical injury to a human being that results in muscle tears or disfiguring lacerations or requires cosmetic or corrective surgery.

(B) **Seizure and impoundment.** If upon investigation it is determined by the Animal Control Officer or law enforcement officer that probable cause exists to believe the dog or animal in question poses an immediate threat to public safety, then the Animal Control Officer or law enforcement officer may seize and impound the animal pending the opportunity for hearing pursuant to this section. The owner or keeper of the animal shall

be liable to the city for the costs and expenses of keeping the animal if it is determined to be potentially dangerous or vicious.

(C) *Notice to owner; opportunity for appeal.*

(1) The Animal Control Officer or law enforcement officer shall attempt to notify the owner or keeper of the animal in writing of the impoundment and of the determination that the dog or animal is potentially dangerous or vicious. The notification shall include any requirements to be imposed upon the restraint and enclosure of the animal and if the animal is proposed to be humanely destroyed.

(2) The notice shall also contain information that the officer's determination may be appealed to the Board of Administrative Appeals, within the time specified in this code.

(3) The Board of Administrative Appeals may decide all issues for or against the owner or keeper of the animal, even if he or she does not appear at the hearing.

(D) *Destruction of dangerous dog or animal.*

(1) A dog or animal determined to be vicious may be humanely destroyed by the Animal Control Department when it is found that the release of the animal would create a significant threat to public health, safety and welfare, and when the time for filing an appeal with the Board of Administrative Appeals has lapsed, or if an appeal is filed, when the Board determined to overrule the appeal.

(2) If it is determined that a dog or animal found to be vicious shall not be destroyed, the officer shall impose conditions upon the ownership and custody of the dog or animal that protect the public health, safety and welfare.

(E) When dog or animal shall not be destroyed. No dog or animal may be declared potentially dangerous or vicious if any injury or damage is sustained by a person who, at the time the injury or damage was sustained, was committing a willful trespass or other tort upon the premises occupied by the owner or keeper of the animal, or was teasing, tormenting, abusing or assaulting it, or was committing or attempting to commit a crime. No dog or animal shall be declared potentially dangerous or vicious if it was protecting or defending a person within the immediate vicinity of the dog or animal from an unjustified attack or assault. No dog or animal shall be declared potentially dangerous or vicious if the injury or damage was sustained by a domestic animal which at the time was teasing, tormenting, abusing or assaulting the dog or animal.

**ANTIOCH ANIMAL SERVICES**  
**DANGEROUS ANIMAL DECLARATION**  
**TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

**Dog Owner:**

Pursuant to Antioch Municipal Code Section 6-1.22, on September 18, 2012, the following animals are declared to be **POTENTIALLY DANGEROUS ANIMALS.**

- **"Bubba" - a male, red/white Pit Bull ID# A507033**
- **"Roxy" - a female, red/white Pit Bull ID# A102104**
- **"Chevelle" - a female, red Pit Bulls ID# A102105**

The Owner or Custodian of the above described dogs is hereby directed to keep the animals under strict restraint and control at all times. An Animal Control Officer of the City of Antioch may seize the animals and petition to have them humanely euthanized in the event the animals are found in violation of any restriction and/or condition outlined below:

1. If not all Owners of the subject dogs sign this Agreement, the signing Owner represents that he/she has the authority of the other Owners to sign on their behalf. \_\_\_\_\_
2. Antioch Animal Services shall have the authority, at reasonable times, to inspect and approve the area of confinement of the declared Potentially Dangerous Dogs. \_\_\_\_\_

**DOGS: "Bubba" #A507033, "Roxy" #A102104, "Chevelle" #A102105**

3. Adult Owner(s) and dogs must enroll in, and satisfactorily complete, a basic obedience/aggressive dog training course within 90 days of release. **Proof of satisfactory completion must be presented to Antioch Animal Services within 5 business days of completion.** \_\_\_\_\_
4. Prior to release, the dogs shall be micro-chipped for permanent identification at the Owner's expense and the identification numbers registered with Home Again Pet Recovery as provided in the microchip information packet at the Owner's expense. \_\_\_\_\_
5. Prior to release, the dogs shall be spayed or neutered at the Owner's expense. An employee of Antioch Animal Services will transport the dogs to an Antioch Veterinarian approved by the Owner. \_\_\_\_\_
6. The dogs when in public, must wear a humane muzzle, a dog harness and be restrained by a leash not exceeding 6 feet in length and under the control of a competent adult. \_\_\_\_\_
7. The dogs shall not be allowed loose in the front yard. \_\_\_\_\_
8. The dogs must not be left unattended or tethered in the front yard. \_\_\_\_\_
9. Owner must post a "BEWARE OF DOG" sign at each entry gate to rear/side yards. The sign must depict the head of a growling dog. \_\_\_\_\_
10. An adult must be present and supervising the dogs when they are loose in the side and/or rear yards. \_\_\_\_\_
11. Owner is required to have a large outside dog kennel. [See attached for Kennel Requirements] When the dogs are unsupervised in the side and/or rear yard, they must be kept in a totally enclosed kennel with gates locked. The kennel must be inspected and approved by an Animal Control Officer prior to release of the dogs. \_\_\_\_\_
12. Exit gates and/or doors from premises must be self-closing, self-latching and in good operating order. \_\_\_\_\_
13. A security screen door must be properly installed on the front door entrance of the premises. \_\_\_\_\_
14. Doors leading from the rear of side yards and/or residence into garage must be self-closing, self-latching and in good operating order. \_\_\_\_\_
15. The dogs must be kept current on rabies vaccination and dog license. \_\_\_\_\_

**DOGS: "Bubba" #A507033, "Roxy" #A102104, "Chevelle" #A102105**

16. Owner must immediately contact Antioch Animal Services whenever the dogs escape the Owner's premises or whenever they bite a human or animal. \_\_\_\_\_
17. Owner must comply with all applicable animal care and control laws. \_\_\_\_\_
18. Owner must advise any and all caregivers/custodians of the dogs of these terms and conditions. \_\_\_\_\_
19. All fees owing to the City of Antioch will be paid prior to release of the dogs. \_\_\_\_\_
20. The Owner or Keeper of the declared Potentially Dangerous Animal must present to the Supervisor of Animal Services proof that the Owner or Keeper has procured liability insurance from an insurer licensed to practice in the state of California, in a single incident amount of not less than one hundred thousand dollars for each animal, for injury to or death of any person or persons, or loss or damage to any property caused by or resulting from any act of such animal. Liability insurance shall not be canceled unless the Owner or Keeper ceases to own or keep the animal prior to expiration of that insurance. Coverage shall be evidenced by a certificate issued by the insurer. The Owner shall also provide documentation from the insurer warranting that the insurer will provide Antioch Animal Services at least thirty days advance notice of cancellation of insurance. \_\_\_\_\_

Please be advised that the owner of the property where the dogs reside will be notified of the animals "Potentially Dangerous Animal" status and a copy of this declaration will be issued as a courtesy through registered mail.

Owner acknowledges that the above-described dogs have been declared to be a **"POTENTIALLY DANGEROUS ANIMALS"**, and agrees to comply with the Terms and Conditions of this agreement and acknowledges that any violation of these terms and conditions may result in Antioch Animal Services seizing the dogs and recommending that the animal be euthanized.

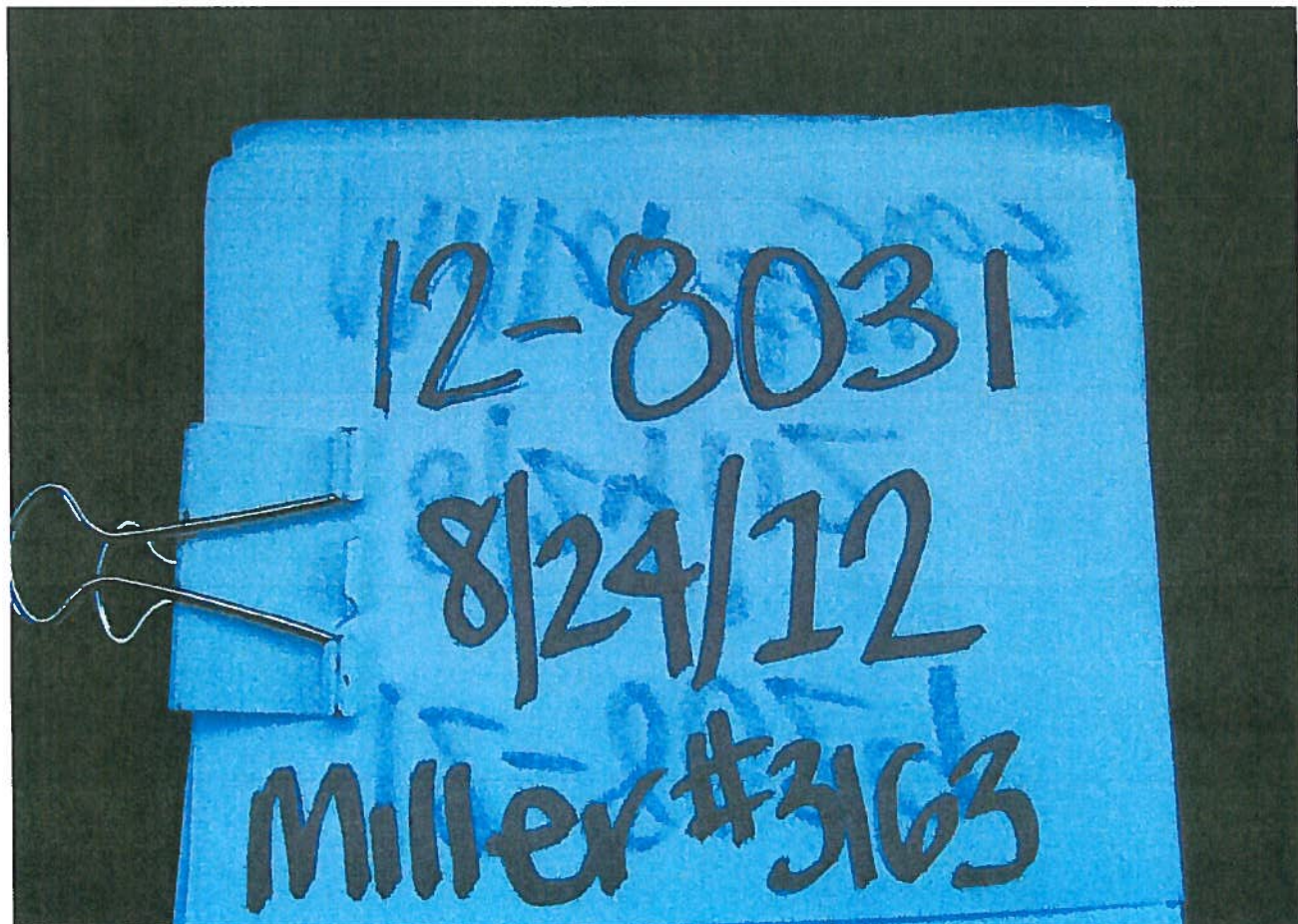

On Sep 19, 2012 8:12 AM, "Cristal Reyes" wrote:

On August 24, 2012 At 6:17pm My husband Victor Reyes was attacked by the neighbors three pitbulls. My name is Maria Estela Reyes and i am Victor Reyes's Wife It was Friday afternoon i have a newborn of 2 months i was feeding my child in my bedroom when my Husband Victor Reyes told me he was going outside to wash his car, and he left not even 2 minutes passed by when i heard some terrifying screams from my husband outside and dog barks. I put my baby down and i left running, opening the door to the garage i saw the three dogs that were on top of my husband biting him, and the two owners of the dogs one tall man with his shirt off and tattoos all over his chest and a skinny tall women with blonde hair were taking off the three dogs of my husband, My husband was on the floor injured on his left arm and left leg. Immediately i grabbed the phone and called an ambulance, and the two owners put there dogs inside there black Mercedes-Benz, and my daughter Cristal Reyes was taking pictures of there license plate before they fled. They did not ask or come back and see if my husband was ok, all they kept on saying was "We are sorry" and left. The police and ambulance came and my husband had to go to the emergency room because of the bite on his left foot being in so deep. This was everything i saw with my own two eyes when my husband got attacked by the neighbors three dogs

My name is Victor Reyes and on the afternoon of Friday August 24, 2012 i was attacked by three pit bulls that belonged to the next door neighbors. I had told my wife i was going outside to wash my car cause it had been a while so it needed a wash. I opened the garage and i moved one of my trucks to the side curb so i could take out my other car that was inside the garage. Right as i was stepping into my garage when i heard a rustling through the bottom of the trees, it was one of the dogs viciously coming at me and then the other two i rushed back into my garage as fast as i could but the dogs knocked me down, i feel the immense burn and pain when one of the dogs bit my left ankle and the other two on my left arm. I tried taking them off but all i could do i scream for help from somebody, i could hear both the man and female yelling at there dogs to get come back to them and they rushed to take of there dogs while they were still biting me. I heard when my wife was yelling hysterically cause she saw me being attacked by the dogs. After they had taken there dogs off of me i layed there in pain until the cops and paramedics came so they could check me and write up the report. I had to go to the Emergency room to get checked, and get stitches on my left ankle. At the time of the accident there was a husky type of guy with tattoos and and skinny white women with blonde hair and they fled after their dogs had bit me

The dogs ran after him into the garage. He attempted to back up but ran out of room, and the three dogs began biting him and attacking him.

The neighbor, who is unidentified at this time, came over and grabbed the dogs off of him and took them back over to his house.

Silva described the three dogs as three fully grown pit bulls, two all brown and one all black. Silva could not provide any further description of the dogs.

The suspected owner he described as a white male adult, approximately 30 to 35 years old, 5'11" to 6'0" tall, stocky build, with several tattoos all over his body. It should be noted that the suspected owner was shirtless at the time, making it possible for him to see all these tattoos. The white male had a shaved head and was wearing black and white plaid long shorts.

His daughter, Reyes, was able to snap a photo of the suspected owner as he fled with the three dogs in his black Mercedes-Benz. The suspected plate of the black Mercedes-Benz that showed to be in the picture that Reyes took is Silva was not able to provide any further information.

I spoke with Reyes about what had occurred. Reyes stated the following in summary.

Her dad was getting ready to wash his vehicle, and she heard him yelling and screaming from inside the house. She ran out of the house to see what was going on, and that is when she saw the dogs attacking her father, and the suspected owner from next door at Redwood Drive came over and pulled the dogs off of her father.

The suspected owner fled the scene in a black Mercedes with the dogs inside. She was able to snap a photo of him next to the vehicle he fled in with her camera phone. After snapping the picture, she sent it to me. Reyes had nothing further to add.

I attempted contact at Redwood Drive. No one answered the door, and it appeared everyone had left the house.

The license plate of came back to a 1995 Mercury out of Walnut Creek. The plate does not match the vehicle in the photograph. It appears this plate is on the wrong vehicle. The registered owner showed to be a Jacqueline Wight. I ran Wight in RMS and in Aries and found a prior address of Asilomar Dr. I later responded to this address and found the house to be vacant. There were no vehicles in front of the residence. I also located a phone number for Wight, I called this number and didn't receive an answer. I left a message with my information for Wight to call me back.

I ran this vehicle in ARIES and only found numerous CLETS requests on the plate, but there wasn't any information on the vehicle.

I sent out a BOLO to all on-duty Brentwood and APD units for the vehicle and a description of the suspect.

I placed a copy of the photograph from Reyes into the case file jacket.
