REQUEST:

Mr. George Stamm request a hearing to appeal the notice of intent to record a lien for unpaid fees and fines related to Code Enforcement case CD1606-057.

Antioch Municipal Code Sections:

§ 5-1.202 SPECIFIC NUISANCES PROHIBITED.

A (2) Premises on which overgrown, dead or decayed trees, weeds or other vegetation pose a risk of harm to the public, or constitute visual blight or reduce the aesthetic appearance of the neighborhood, or are offensive to the senses, or are detrimental to the use and enjoyment of nearby properties, or reduce nearby property values due to its visibility from the public right-of-way;

And

§ 7-2.623 TREES, HEDGES, FENCES, AND SHRUBBERY.

A (2) No tree, hedge, shrub, or other planting whatever, fence, or similar structure shall be maintained across any existing walkway in a sidewalk area or shoulder. The intent of this restriction is to keep free a walkway for pedestrian or other lawful public travel without interference by or with vehicular travel. No encroachment of any nature shall be permitted or maintained which impedes, obstructs, or denies such pedestrian or other lawful travel within the limits of the right-of-way of a public street or which impairs adequate sight distance for safe pedestrian or vehicular traffic.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

 On June 9, 2016 I was at this location and observed that the vegetation along the wall/fence line was overgrown and encroaching on the public right-of-way. A Notice of Violation was issued for the overgrown vegetation encroaching on the public right-of-way; the notice was posed on the fence in the front of the property and photos were taken (See attached A). The notice was also mailed to the recorded property owner Stamm, George F & Barbara at 505 B Street Antioch, CA 94509-1202 (Property owner)(See Attached B).

- 2) On June 21, 2016 I received a call from George Stamm (925-437-1583) stating that he could not read the copy of the notice that was posted to the fence. I returned the call and left a voicemail explaining the violation and how to correct it.
- 3) On June 28, 2016 I left another voicemail for George Stamm (925-437-1583) regarding the overgrown vegetation and that it needed to be trimmed off the public right-of way so that pedestrians could pass freely on the sidewalk with no encroachments.
- 4) On July 13, 2016 I was at the location for a re-inspection. At that time the vegetation remained overgrown and encroaching on the public right-of-way. Citation #25868 was issued for \$100 along with a \$200 re-inspection fee. The citation and re-inspection fee were mailed to the recorded property owner. Photos were taken at the time of inspection (See attachment C).
- 5) On August 25, 2016 I was at this location for a re-inspection. At that time the vegetation had been trimmed back off of the sidewalk in the areas around the trees. The case was closed as the violation had been corrected. Photos were taken at that time (See attached D).
- 6) On August 2, 2016 the Finance Department sent invoice number AR146370 for a total of \$310 for citation number 25868, late charge, and re-inspection fee. Invoice was mailed to the property owner. (See attached E)
- 7) On September 27, 2016 a Notice of Intent to Record Lien for outstanding fees and fines was mailed to the property owner. (See attached F)
- 8) On October 3, 2016 the request to appeal fines and intent to record a lien was received from the property owner. (See attached G)
- 9) On October 4, 2016 a response to the request for an appeals hearing stating that the appeal had been scheduled for November 3, 2016 was mailed to the property owner. (See attached H)
