## **CONTINUED PUBLIC HEARINGS**

2. UP-02-15 – B/M OPEN STORAGE – Bill Munoz requests approval of a Use Permit to allow an outdoor boat/recreational vehicle storage facility on an approximately 0.6 acre site, and a minor subdivision to create 3 lots from two existing lots. The project site is located at the northwest corner of East 18<sup>th</sup> Street and Olive Lane. (APN: 065-235-006 and 020).

This item was continued from February 19, 2003. Staff recommends this item be continued to a future meeting so that the applicant has adequate time to meet with City staff to review and revise the proposal.

# **NEW PUBLIC HEARINGS**

- 3. **UP-01-1/A- REV. ANNA AYESH** requests modification to the conditions of an approved use permit to allow both a convenience store with liquor sales and a "99 Cent" retail store in an existing building. Specifically the applicant requests the Planning Commission wave the requirement that the applicant complete all improvements prior to opening the facility for operation. The existing building is located on the Northeast corner of "L" Street and West 10<sup>th</sup> Street. (APN 66-217-007 and 014).
- 4. **UP-02-32 GEORGE STAMM** requests a use permit to allow the area expansion of an existing market into the existing theatre and the creation of an approximately 3,000 sq. ft. sheet metal shop into the remainder of the theatre building. The project is located at 912 G Street (APN 066-206-010 and 012).
