# **NEW PUBLIC HEARING**

1. UP-21-09, AR-21-07 – Promenade Phases 4 – 6 – The applicant, Tri-Pointe Homes, requests Use Permit and Design Review approval for the construction of phases 4-6, new home architecture for the Promenade at Sand Creek Phases 4-6 new homes. The Proposes project will be developed as part of the previously approved Vineyards at Sand Creek. The subject property is location on the west side of Heidorn Ranch Road south of Prewett Ranch Road and the east side of Hillcrest Avenue north of the future extension of Sand Creek Road (APNs: 057-030-012, -013, -014, -017, -018).

Adopt the resolution APPROVING a Use Permit and Design Review (UP-21-09, AR-21-07) for the construction of phases 4-6, home architecture for the new homes in Promenade at Sand Creek Phases 4-6, subject to conditions of approval.

2. AMPORTS Antioch Vehicle Processing Facility (UP-20-14, AR20-18, V-21-04) The applicant, AMPORTS, requests approval of an Initial Study/Mitigated Negative Declaration and Mitigation Monitoring and Reporting Program and approval of a Use Permit, Design Review, and Variance to develop an automotive logistics and processing facility for vehicles prior to their distribution to dealerships. The project includes the conversion and upgrade of the existing wharf for roll on/roll off operations, construction of a new building, and new site improvements - including new paving, stormwater improvements, and fencing. The project is located at 2301 Wilbur Avenue (APNs 051-020-006 and 051-020-012).
