1. Staff Communication

The Antioch Water Park has received concrete upgrades to 6,000 square feet of deck area due to age; wear & tear. Expressed appreciation for firefighters and their work extinguishing the wetlands fire next to the Marina – saved the Marina. Keep Antioch Beautiful should improve promotions, they dropped the ball it appears. Start early for Coastal Clean Up. Suggestion was made to continue discussing options for Commissioners to visit parks and assist with being "eyes and ears.".
