a. Traffic & Pedestrian Safety Update by John Samuelson, City of Antioch Public Works Director

Signage and Striping Improvements to Address Safety of the Traveling Public in and Around School Sites

Multiple school sites were discussed with striping and signage described as the next measures to be implemented. Planned 18th Street improvements include high visibility pedestrian crossings, increased school signage and a hawk signal. Trustee Rocha requested installation of speed humps on 18th Street. Mr. Samuelson expressed interest in meeting with the new AHS principal. Council Member Torres-Walker is opposed to speed humps on 18th Street, given it is a highly traveled roadway segment.

Trustee Rocha identified unique conditions at Turner Elementary School that need further attention. Trustee Lewis noted that a school is missing from the sites the City listed. It is the charter academy at the fairgrounds.

Committee concurred with implementation of the identified improvements as soon as possible.
