These commands appeared to sway the suspect into surrendering without incident.

Perro was then sent again and called off approximately half way to the decoy in a down position, Perro was then given the command to bite again and apprehended the decoy without issue. Perro was given a verbal out and he released the bite without additional commands needed.

Perro showed strong drive during this exercise and was using his nose well to search instead of having his head up searching with his eyes. Perro was able to locate the hiding decoy behind the closed door and remained at the door barking trying to get inside until the decoy opened the door allowing Perro to bite the decoy bite suit. Perro remained on the bite until I safely made my way into the room and removed him from the bite using a verbal command with a low level e-collar overlay.

Comments

Perro searched on a 15 long leash. Perro was downwind of the first unloaded firearm under the plywood, he quickly picked up the sent and began sniffing the bottom of the box area before alerting by barking and staying in place while looking back at me. Perro was rewarded with a toy and then again sent to detect odor. Perro picked up the sent of the live .223 rounds which were approximately 10 feet from the unloaded pistol. Perro stuck his nose into the pallet where the live rounds were and attempted to grab them with his mouth. Perro alerted to this item by barking and looking back at me. Perro was rewarded and then sent again to detect odor in the open area. The next item Perro came across was the buried unloaded pistol. Perro took some time to bracket this odor and I stayed in place approximately 5 feet from the pistol and allowed Perro to use all 15 feet of his line. Perro was then able to stick his nose to the ground and moved the brush around where he located on the firearm. Perro barked and looked back at me, however he attempted to come back towards me in anticipation of his toy. I corrected him and made him stay in place before rewarding him with the toy. He was then sent again to detect odor near the conex boxes where the small box of spent shell casings was hidden in the handle area approximately 4 feet high. Perro picked up the odor and was sniffing hard on the edges of the box doors. Perro alerted to one side of the box doors nearby the shell casings but was not rewarded and was given another command to sniff. Perro then was able to bracket the odor and jumped up on the box sticking his nose directly into the opening where the shell casings were. Perro alerted by barking and looking back at me before being rewarded with the toy.

I would throw the tug out in front of Perro and ensured he did not release from a heal to retrieve the toy until given the command. Perro then was called off half way to the toy with a minor e-collar overlay before being brought back to a heal and then allowed to retrieve the toy. Perro showed no issues with these basic obedience commands or call offs. This was conducted on a grass field with no other people or animals around.

Perro brought me to the area of the hiding decoy where the scenario was set up for handler decision making. Decoy was holding a fake dog (acting as a real dog) making the handler quickly determine if this scenario is applicable for a K9. Decision was made that due to possible dog on dog aggression a K9 would not be applicable for this apprehension of the decoy.

Comments

From the start of this track, Perro showed strong drive pulling hard on his harness. Half way to the decoy location (unknown at start), Perro showed a change of behavior and had his head down while bracketing odor in wind blowing towards us. Perro successfully located the hiding decoy in a thick tree/brush area biting onto a bite sleeve. Perro was removed from the bite with a verbal command and e-collar overlay. On the way back to the start location, Perro successfully located the two hidden articles by alerting to each in a "bark and guard" on each item. I worked Perro going into a down position at the detection location where he was rewarded with a toy.
