Response to Questions Dated May 25, 2023

Response to Questions:

- 1. Question: Are we able to subcontract any of the work out? Answer: Yes, as long as all subcontractors meet the criteria detailed in the RFP.
- 2. Question: Is there an estimate on bid price? Answer: No, not at this time.
- Question: Has this project been out for bids in the past? If so, who won the bid and what was their bid proposal?
 Answer: Yes, Stewart's tree service is the current Contractor and their proposal should be available to view on The City's website.
- Question: Do we provide a bond for our bid amount or is a bond only needed if we are awarded the contract?
 Answer: No, a bid bond is not required to submit your bid.
- Question: Is there a preference given to companies with higher insurance coverage? I have 10 million general liability policy with NO wildfire exclusion.
 Answer: No, not at this time.
- 6. Question: Is there a preference given to DBE, minority, or small businesses? Answer: No, not at this time.
- 7. Question: What is the estimated date to begin the project? Answer: July 1, 2023
- 8. Question: Do you have a tree assessment form we would use or is the one we currently use ok? Answer: We can supply you with one if your current form is unsatisfactory.
- 9. Question: Is all work climbing work? You do not mention the need for an aerial lift. Answer: It is up to you in your proposal to recommend how you plan on servicing the contract.

- 10. Question: Is there an area where we can park trucks and equipment overnight during the term of the contract?Answer: There is not one provided by the City you would need to make your own arrangements.
- 11. Question: Is all tree work on call or is there enough work for weeks on end? Answer: There is a current backlog of tree work but zero guarantees of work as stated in the RFP.
- 12. Question: For line items 1 and 2, can personnel that make up the four-person crew be utilized as flaggers or are additional personnel beyond the four-person crew required when flagging is needed? Answer: They can be the same person, that is for you to decide as part of your proposal.
- 13. Question: For line item 4, is this a flat fee above the hourly rate for the crew per emergency call out? Answer: That is for you to decide if 24-hour call-out rates will be charged different than OT or straight time rates and must be detailed in your proposal.
- 14. Question: Is it permissible to have a wildfire exclusion on our General Liability insurance policy? Answer: Please refer to the RFP for City required insurance information.
- 15. Question: For the purpose of the Performance and Payment bonds, will this be based on a "not to exceed amount" for the contract since the submitted prices are hourly? Answer: Bond information is included in the RFP.
