Questions and Answers

Q-1. We currently serve as the monitor for a state Consent Decree (Colorado), would this prevent us from participating from the City's of DOJ's perspective?

A-1. No

- Q-2. What level of resources (FTEs) will the Department/City be providing to the project for testing/implementation and compliance with the agreement?
- A-2. The City agreed to add four (4) FTE positions to assist with the project: A police captain, a police sergeant, an assistant city attorney, and a Data and Statistical Policy Analyst. Refer to Section IV. Monitoring, subsection B of the MOA.
- Q-3. I hope you are well. I am writing in relation to RFQ-030625, which is the consultant role for assisting with the implementation of the MOU between Antioch and the US DOJ. When reviewing the sample Consulting Services/Professional Services sample agreement, Section 2 references an attached Exhibit A relating to compensation. However, the exhibit is not attached to the document. Will this exhibit be created upon

selection of consultant, or is it a standard form? If it is standard, will you please forward a copy to ensure that my proposal is in alignment with the acceptable budgetary requirements.

A-3. Exhibit A will serve as an exhibit to the Professional Services Agreement between the City and the Consultant, and it will be created upon the selection of the Consultant.
