#### January 16, 2019 ~ Crocker Museum/Old Sacramento

Your day begins with a docent led tour of the Crocker Art Museum, the longest continuously-operating art museum in the West. After your tour the group will head over to Old Sacramento to board the docked Delta King steamboat and experience the era of Mark Twain and steamboats on the Sacramento River. Aboard the docked Delta King you will enjoy a delicious hosted lunch. After lunch you will have free time to walk away Old Sacramento.
