

COURTESIES

- All guests must purchase a ticket, whether they plan to swim or not. Re-entry is only allowed with wristband.
- Wristbands are required for all guests over 30" tall.
- Guests must follow park rules and requests of park staff.
- Do not climb on rocks.
- Food & drinks must be kept at least 6 feet away from the pools and slides.
- Children under 9 must be actively supervised by someone at least 15 years of age. Children ages 9-12 need signed permission to attend without an adult.
- No running, diving, or jumping into pools.
- All bags will be searched. No alcohol or glass containers.
- Smoking of any kind is not permitted in the park.
- Pets are not allowed in the park, with the exception of service animals. Service animals are not allowed in the water.
- Public intoxication, unlawful drug use, vandalism, or any other violation of City, County, State, Federal or Park Rules will result in ejection from park without refund and possible criminal prosecution.
- The Water Park and it's attractions are subject to closure at any time, without notice, at the discretion of park management.
- The Water Park is not liable for any lost, stolen or damaged personal property.

DRESS CODE

- Traditional swimwear is required. Revealing attire, street clothes, cut-offs, basketball shorts, gym clothes, and clothing with rivets, snaps, buttons, belts, or metal are not permitted.
- Swim diapers are required for all diapered guests.
- Only Coast Guard approved Type III life jackets are allowed in the facility.
- Snorkles, face masks, and fins are not allowed.

HEALTH & SAFETY

- Please shower before enjoying our pools and attractions.
- Guests that have had stomach and/or intestinal issues illness within the past two weeks should not enter the water.
- Guests with open wounds or bandages are not permitted to enter the water.
- Guests are required to wash their hands after using the restroom and/or changing a diaper. Diaper changing on or around the pool deck is not allowed.
- Do not drink water from any pools or attractions.
- Please report all injuries to park staff.
