## FOR PERMANENT BERTHERS

## Antioch Marina will assign Marina Keys only to the person(s) signing the <u>PERMIT TO BERTH VESSEL</u> at the Antioch Marina.

Berthers at the Antioch Marina must comply with the Marina Rules and Regulations and the Antioch Marina Ordinance, as amended from time to time, and by these rules and regulations as they relate to the access to berths and facilities in the Antioch Marina.

A serial number identifies marina keys. Marina keys remain under control of the Antioch Marina. Berthers and persons in possession of keys may have their keys rendered inoperable upon violation of the Marina Ordinance and/or Marina Rules and Regulations

## I AGREE TO THE FOLLOWING:

- 1. I will pay the City of Antioch a \$10.00 one-time fee for each Marina key received. The key becomes my property but remains under the control of the Antioch Marina.
- 2. I assume all responsibility for each Marina key purchased. The marina will replace the key if it becomes unusable for reasons not attributable to my handling of the key.
- 3. I will not use or allow the key to be used in a manner inconsistent with the Marina Ordinance, the Marina Rules and Regulations and Marina Live Aboard Regulations.
- 4. I will not give, assign or lend the Marina key to any person who is not a guest or crewmember on my boat, or who is not employed by me to work on my boat.
- 5. I will not attempt to have the key copied or duplicated in any manner whatsoever.
- 6. I understand the marina may render my key temporarily inoperable if I, or persons using my key, violate the Antioch Marina Ordinance or Marina Regulations.
- 7. I agree that the marina will lock out my key upon my vacating the berth. I may keep the key and have it re-activated if I rent another berth at the marina in the future.
